Spring Ice Update



We are faced yet again with the disappointing news from the Sunshine Coast Regional District that ice will not remain installed at either of the Ice Arenas this spring season. Over the past many years, SCSC Board Members have lobbied for spring ice. We have raised the many concerns over loss of training ground, the increased cost to families for travel to ice arenas off Coast, the damaging effects this has on our youth's mental and physical health, training, and competition eligibility but this important advocacy seems to fall on deaf ears. On April 4th, ice will be removed from both facilities. This decision does not have to be perpetual. Elected officials who care for our youth and their wellness, will re-evaluate this decision. We encourage all of our members to write a letter in support to your elected official.
